### **Club Dues**

The annual club dues will remain at \$40 for the year. This fee includes tournament fees, handicapping service, prizes and awards. Participants 18 years old and younger are free. The club may purchase lunch at selected tournaments. Guests are not eligible to win any prizes or proximity contests. Guests are limited to a maximum of two tournaments a year. Dues must be paid no later than June 1, 2023 or the member will forfeit their club membership.

#### **Prizes**

We will continue giving cash prizes to outing winners and golf balls for proximity winners. Each proximity winner will also again receive 1 entry per win into a Proximity Raffle for a CASH prize of \$100.00. This will be done for the entire season.

At the Club Banquet, from all the accumulated entries, one winner will be drawn for the men's division and one winner for the women's division. Juniors will continue to receive golf balls as outing prizes.

## **Handicaps**

Our golf club issues golf indexes which will be converted to a course handicap and used in the net competition tournaments that we conduct. Having a golf index enables golfers of varied abilities to compete on an equal basis. We will post all tournament scores, but in order for your golf index to be valid, it is required that <u>all</u> of your golf scores, <u>with name of course</u>, tee used, adjusted score with course rating and slope, be posted. You can do this by contacting Arunas Dagys by text or preferably sending this information to him by e-mail at ArunasD@sbcglobal.net. Directions for adjusting the golf score, as well as the current golf indexes/handicaps for all club members, are available by visiting the club's web site.

## **Competition Classes by Handicap/Golf Index**

We will continue to vary the number of classes and their composition for men and women, depending on the number of golfers participating and their golf indexes. Where the competition is net score by class or gross score by class, the number of classes may be more or less than the 4 men classes and 2 women classes we have used in the past. The range of golf indexes and number of golfers participating will dictate the number of classes and what the class handicap range will be for that tournament. Prizes awarded may vary from 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, or to only 1<sup>st</sup> for a class depending on how many golfers are in a class. Our tournament directors will monitor each tournament's registration and make the necessary determinations in order to make competition as fair and competitive as possible.

In making these adjustments, we are attempting to group golfers of somewhat similar ability and to vary the number of prizes awarded in proportion to the number of golfers participating in a class.

## **Tournament Slow Play**

Slow play in golf is still a major problem. Several of the golf courses have expressed concern about our slow play. It is expected that you and your foursome will keep pace with the foursome in front of you. To play slow is a disservice to the groups behind you. Be part of the solution and not part of the problem. Try to study your putt while the player in front of you is studying their putt. While we think we are good, we are not on the PGA tour. ALSO, do not stop after nine for lunch! Take it with you to the 10<sup>th</sup> tee and play on!

**Tournament Registration** 

Due to golf course booking requirements, it is mandatory that you register with the Tournament Directors eight (8) days, or as specified, prior to the outing. Contact info is noted on the web page. If you have registered and are unable to attend, please contact a Tournament Director ASAP. Failure to do so may result in your responsibility for your greens fee.

### When you arrive at the golf course make sure you check in with a Tournament Director

### Issues at the Course

The club officers ask that if anyone should have an issue/problem at the course during one of our tournaments, please inform Club President or Tournament Director immediately. They have a close relationship with the course personnel and can help to solve the problem without jeopardizing our relationship with the course.

### Golfer of the Year

Our club will track points as they are awarded based on how a golfer performs in our tournaments. The points awarded are cumulative for the year. At the end of the year we honor both the man and woman with the most points as our golfers of the year.

## **Club Banquet**

Immediately following our last scheduled tournament at Silver Lake CC on Oct. 6, we will have an awards ceremony and buffet dinner (approximately 4:00 pm.) The cost of the buffet dinner will be \$35 for adults and juniors 14 and over, and \$20 for 7 to 13 years old.

## **Rules of Competition**

USGA rules apply with the following exceptions:

- 1. You can touch and move the ball 6 inches only if the ball lies in your fairway, otherwise NO TOUCH
- 2. Out of bounds is played as lateral water hazard. One stroke penalty and drop a ball two club lengths from the spot where the ball crossed going into the out of bounds area. Going back on the line of flight more than two club lengths is not permitted under the rules of golf.
- 3. Lost ball is played with a one stoke penalty and dropping a ball where the ball is presumed to have been lost
- 4. Maximum score of 10 on a hole. Once you hit 10, PICK UP THE BALL.
- 5. If necessary, two attempts must be made to cross a hazard, unless there is a drop area.

#### **USGA RULE CHANGES**

We will be using the following changes in CLGK outings:

- \* Your ball must be let go (dropped) from the knee height and fall thru the air without touching any part of your body or equipment.
- \* Looking for a lost ball is now 3 minutes.
- \* The flagstick does not have to be removed when you are putting.
- \* No penalty for accidently moving a ball during a search for lost ball.
- \* No penalty for accidently moving your ball or ball marker on the putting green.
- \* No penalty if your ball in motion is accidently deflected by you or your equipment.
- \* Free relief for an embedded ball anywhere except for sand.
- \* For unplayable lie in a bunker, you can take it out of bunker completely for 2 stroke penalty.
- \* If your club accidently strikes your ball more than once during a stroke, there's no penalty.
- \* If you can't find your ball in a penalty area/out of bounds your options are: (1) drop within 2 club lengths of where it went out of bounds for 1 stroke penalty. (2) Take ball all the way into the fairway no closer to the hole for a 2 stroke penalty.
